Dr. Sivaraja M Member Secretary welcomed the governing council members to the governing council meeting held on 27.09.2025

Agenda wise discussion in the meeting is as follows:

Subject 1	Note on Review on the Confirmation of Previous Minutes & Action Taken Report (2024-25)
Discussion	The Principal presented the Action Taken Report on the resolutions passed in the previous meeting. Members reviewed compliance and progress and expressed satisfaction with the implementation.
Resolution	The Governing Body unanimously confirmed the previous minutes and approved the Action Taken Report.
Subject 2	Note on Academic Review & Student Development
Discussion	The Principal presented academic performance indicators, placement statistics, student support initiatives, and holistic development. Dr. V. Ramachandran emphasized increasing the average placement salary from ₹3.2 LPA to ₹4–6 LPA through better industry collaboration and upskilling. He also recommended integrating SDGs, multidisciplinary and design thinking into curriculum. Dr. M. Santhi suggested addressing low Civil Engg. pass %, offering foreign language training, increasing FDPs, and patent filings. Dr. T. Sekar commended admissions, internships, sports, and NPTEL certifications, and suggested adding faculty ratio, GATE coaching data in reports.
Resolution	The Academic Review and Student Development initiatives were approved. All member recommendations including salary enhancement, structured support for slow learners, integration of SDGs, design thinking, foreign language training, FDP strengthening, GATE coaching, entrepreneurship, and standardized academic reporting shall be implemented in phases.
Subject 3	Note on Progress of the Institution and Achievements
Discussion	Updates included institutional milestones, faculty research, patents, publications, and technical event participation. Appreciation was given by the council. Wider publicity for institutional achievements was recommended via media and digital platforms.



Resolution	Achievements were recorded with recommendations for greater publicity of accomplishments.
Subject 4	Note on Institutional Progress & Achievements
Discussion	Recent infrastructure developments, industry collaborations, accreditations, and recognitions were discussed. The Governing Body was briefed on NBA & NIRF progress and steps for quality enhancement and international linkages.
Resolution	Reported developments approved. Recommended continued focus on quality enhancement and international partnerships.
Subject 5	Note on Statutory Bodies & Approvals
Discussion	Composition and status of IQAC, Academic Council, BoS, Anti-Ragging Committee, ICC, and other statutory bodies were presented. Members reviewed committee functioning and documentation.
Resolution	All statutory committees ratified. Periodic meetings and proper documentation mandated as per regulatory norms.
Subject 6	Note on Institutional Development & Strategic Planning
Discussion	Proposals for infrastructure expansion, innovation ecosystem, and skill-focused academic strengthening were presented. Dr. V. Ramachandran stressed multidisciplinary, SDG-oriented reforms, and a sustainable infrastructure plan. Dr. M. Santhi sought more foreign tie-ups and project funding; Dr. T. Sekar urged for energy audits, MOOC/e-content creation, and SDG courses.
Resolution	Strategic Plan approved. Principal to prepare a time-bound action plan prioritizing feasibility. Promotion of interdisciplinary models, innovation, sustainability, and foreign collaborations endorsed.
Subject 7	Note on Finance & Resource Allocation
Discussion	Principal presented short, mid, and long-term goals with related budget allocations. External funding through CSR and government schemes was discussed as a support mechanism for major goals.
Resolution	Financial proposals and implementation in phases approved. External funding avenues to be explored.



Subject 8	Note on Statutory & Regulatory Compliance
Discussion	Compliance with AICTE, University and other statutory bodies was confirmed. Regular audits and monitoring to maintain zero non-compliance were stressed by members.
Resolution	Compliance status noted and continuous vigilance instructed for regulatory adherence.
Subject 9	Any other items with the permission of the chair
Discussion	Minor operational issues related to maintenance and administration were discussed. No major additional items were tabled.
Resolution	No major additional items. Minor operational concerns were noted for internal action.
