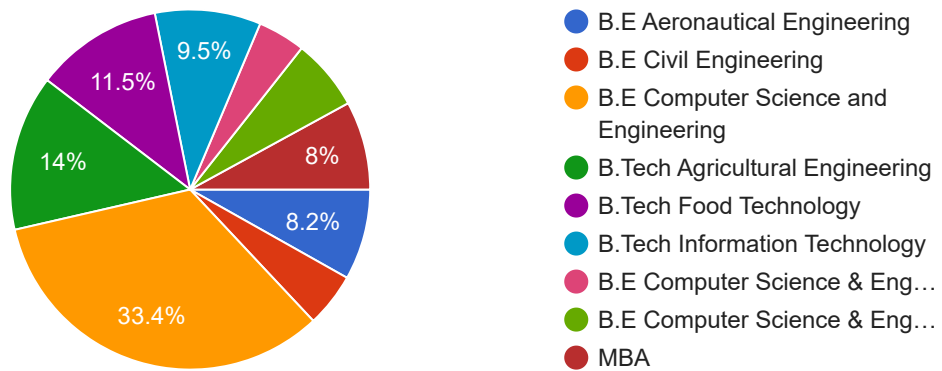

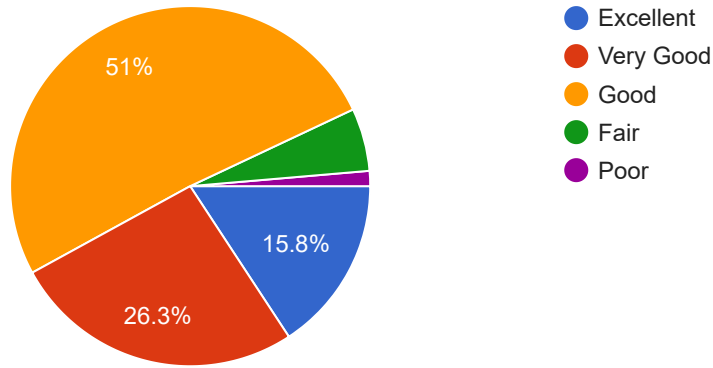

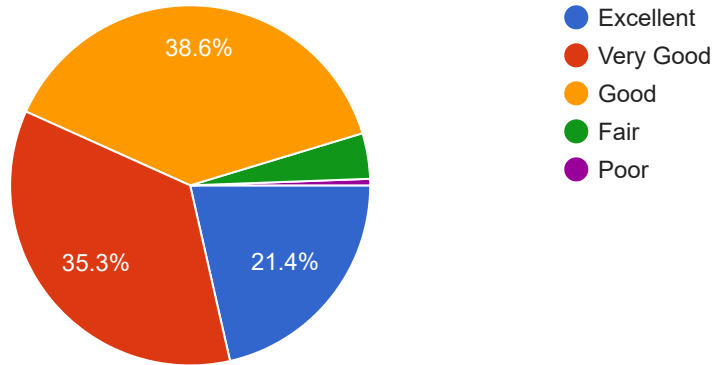
1.How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? Untitled Section

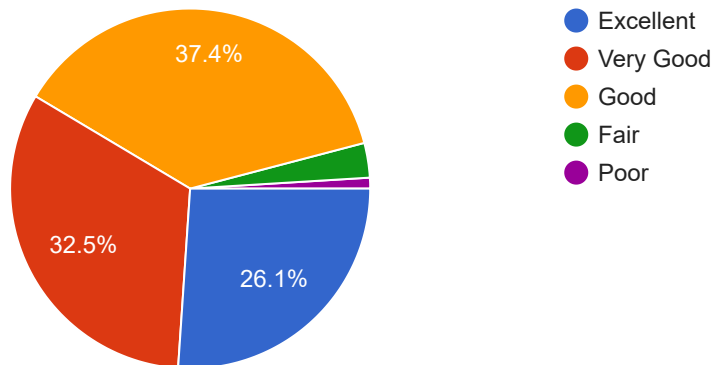
2.How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

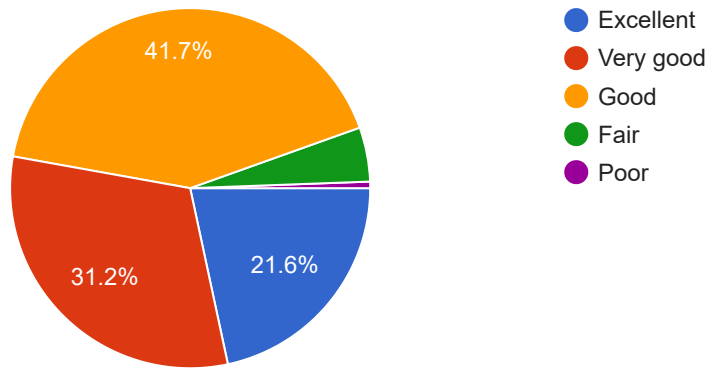

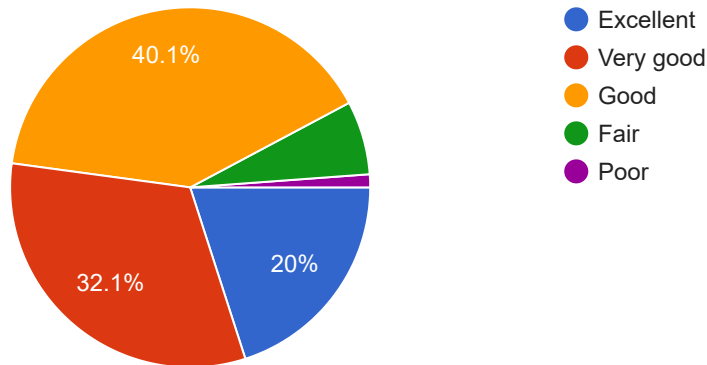

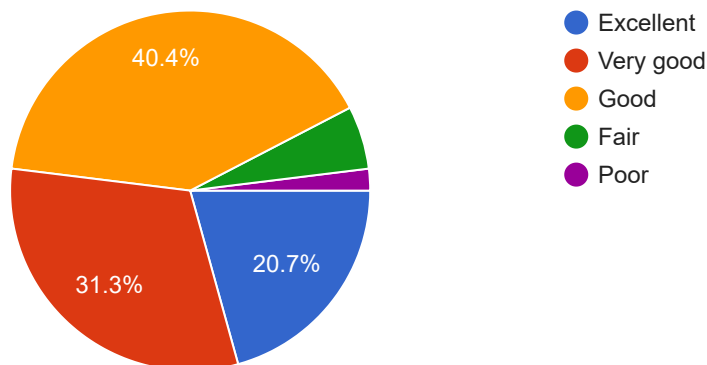

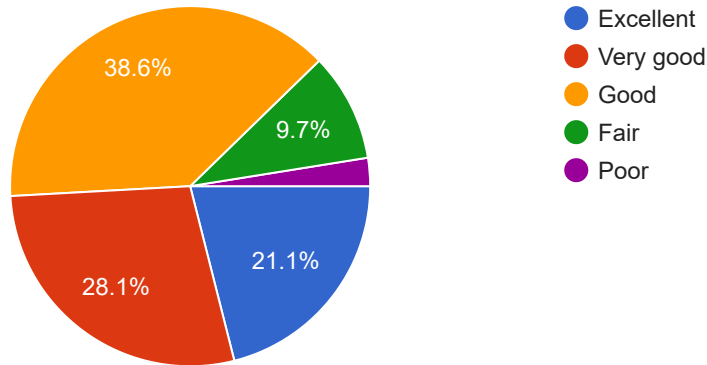

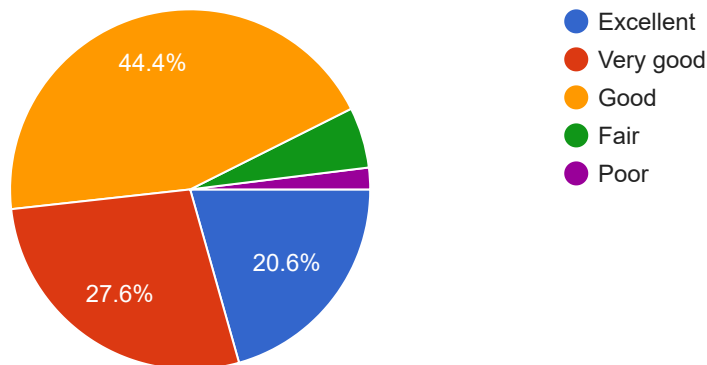

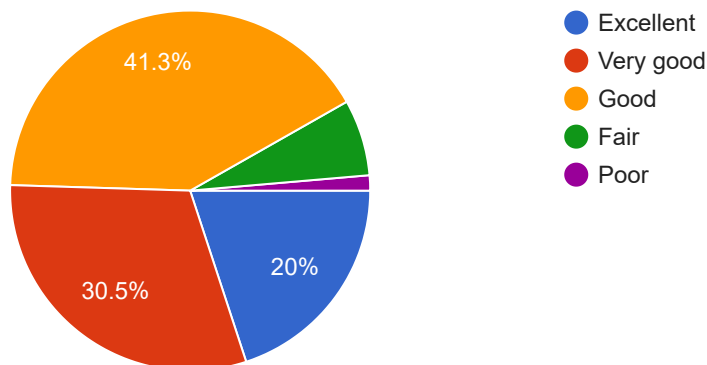

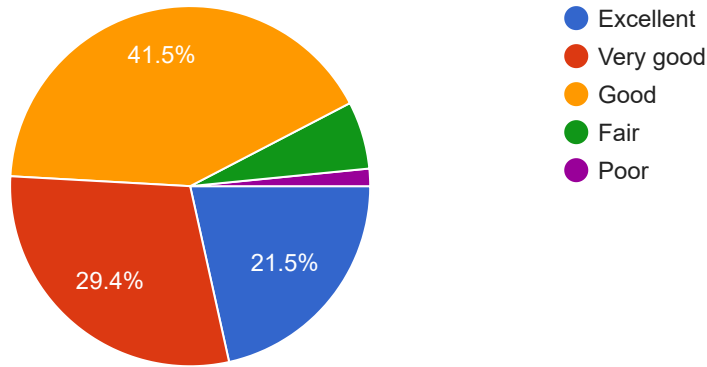

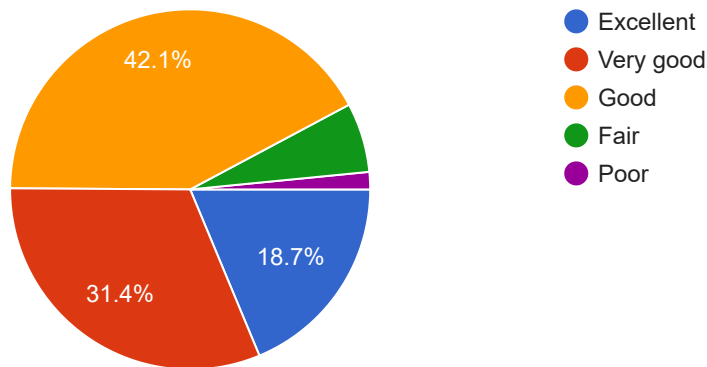

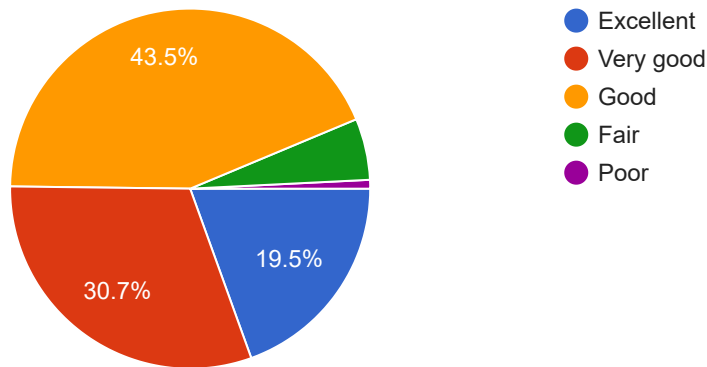

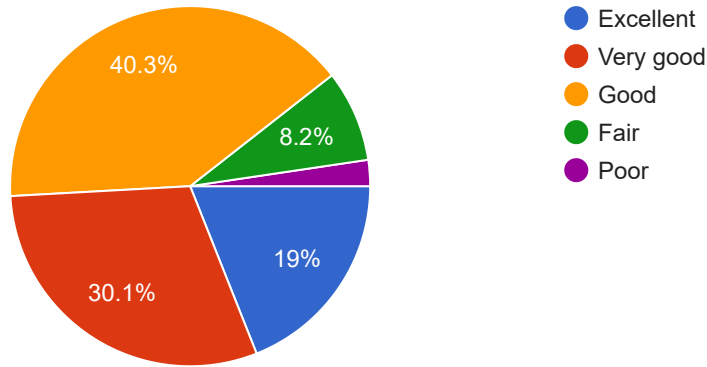

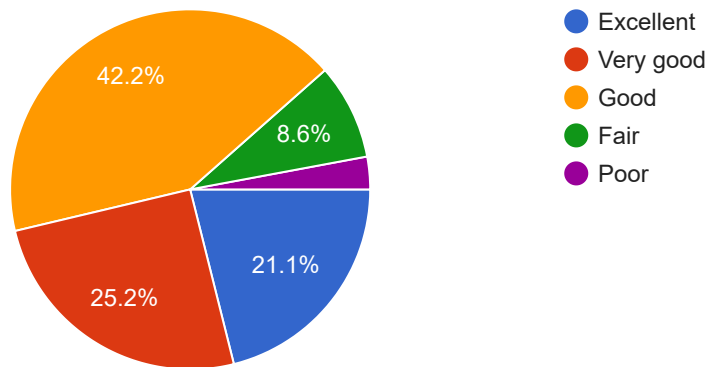

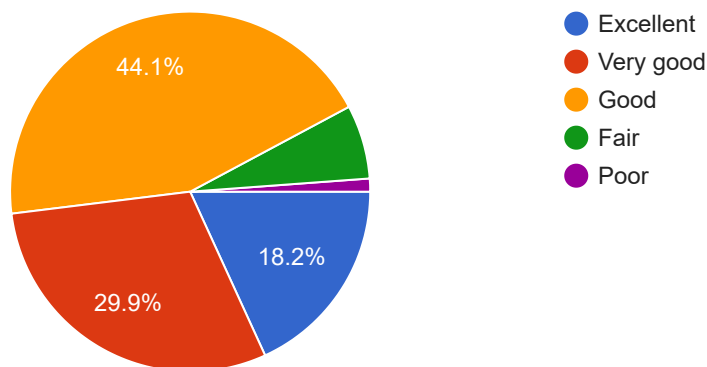

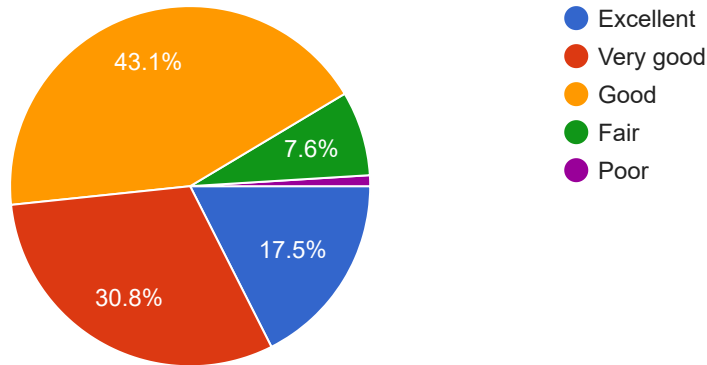

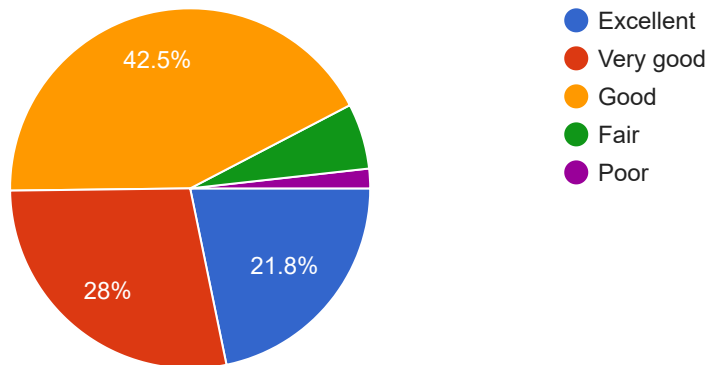

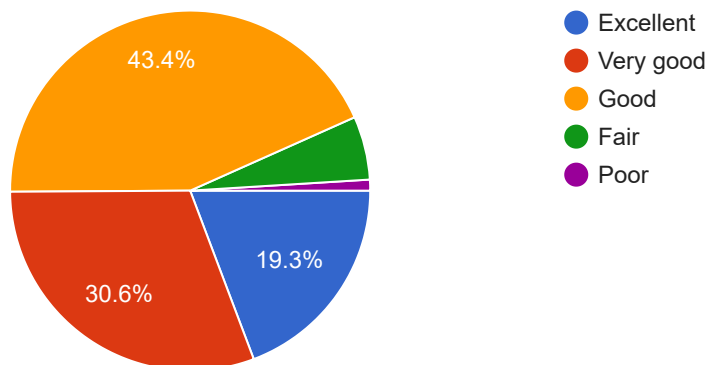

Also, they no longer explain the concepts clearly. They just read or explain it lightly which is hard to understand especially for slow learners.

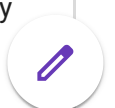
Teachers with poor performance:
